COVID 19
CURRENT RESTRICTIONS
The Covid-19 corona virus is still a major health issue.

The lock-down of the greater Brisbane area has now been lifted. However, there are rules regarding the wearing of masks. These rules apply to people in the greater Brisbane area and to people who visit the greater Brisbane area.

This means if you visit the Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan City, Redlands City or Morton Bay region you must wear a face mask whilst in the area and also when you return home in the following circumstances;

- shopping centres and supermarkets
- hospitals and aged care facilities
- gyms
- workplaces where people cannot socially distance and where it is safe
- places of worship
- libraries
- public transport, taxis and ride share vehicles
- airport terminals and during flights
- staff in restaurants, cafes, pubs and clubs who interact with the public must wear masks but not patrons.

The rules do not apply to Children under 12 or to people with a medical condition, they are exempt. These rules are in place until 1.00am on Friday 22 January 2021

Please remember everyone must still practice physical distancing as much as possible and:

- wash your hands regularly with soap and water, and use alcohol-based sanitiser
- avoid hugs, kisses and handshakes
- wherever possible keep at least 1.5 metres away, two big steps, from people you don't live with.

Public outdoor gatherings are limited to 100 people
Gatherings at private houses are limited to 50 people

Weddings and funerals are limited to 100 people
