WWASC SEWERAGE TREATMENT PLANT

Council have started demolition of the old RBC's (Rotating biological containers) at the WWASC STP (Sewerage Treatment Plant) TruWater was on site Monday 25th January to manage this upgrade.



Three new Kubota treatment plants will be installed to ensure a better quality of effluent to the new irrigation field on the south side.



Construction of the new STP (Sewerage Treatment Plant) will finish around June 2021.

You will need to be patient because there will be questions that need to be asked by the operators, such as, Name, address, details of the incident, name of offenders etc.

WHEN TO PHONE 000

000 is used for URGENT MATTERS such as, if a crime is happening now, a life is threatened, or the offender is still in the area, call Triple Zero – 000.

WHAT IS A NON URGENT REPORT?

Policelink - 131 444

A non-urgent report is something that doesn't require a police officer to attend to as a priority. These include:

- Wilful property damage (e.g. graffiti)
- Break and enter
- Stealing offences
- Stolen vehicles
- Lost property (e.g. lost phone, wallet, jewellery etc)
