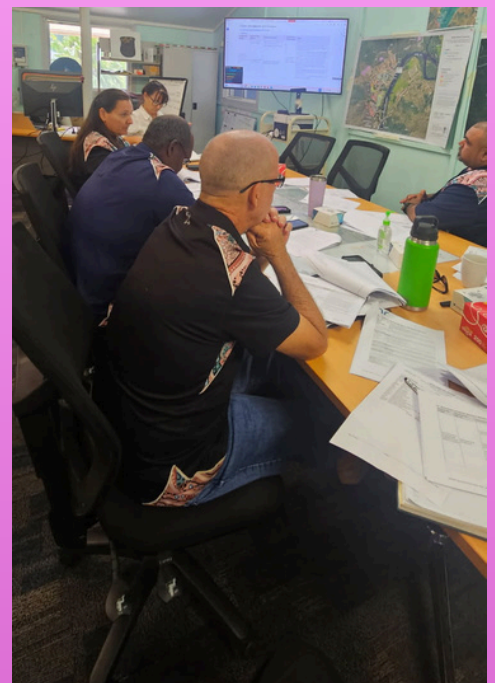
The visit in January 2025 from the Queensland Parks and Wildlife team and reminder to community to keep children away from the river and DO NOT FEED THE CROCODILES!



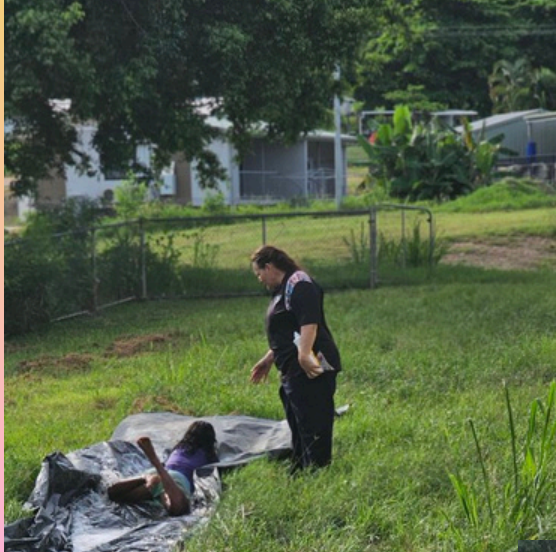
First Council meeting for 2025 was held on the 17th of January. We thank our hardworking Mayor and Councilors for their assistance in the development of our Community.

PILLOWCASE Artwork for our children donated by Red Cross it was apart of the evacuation plan.





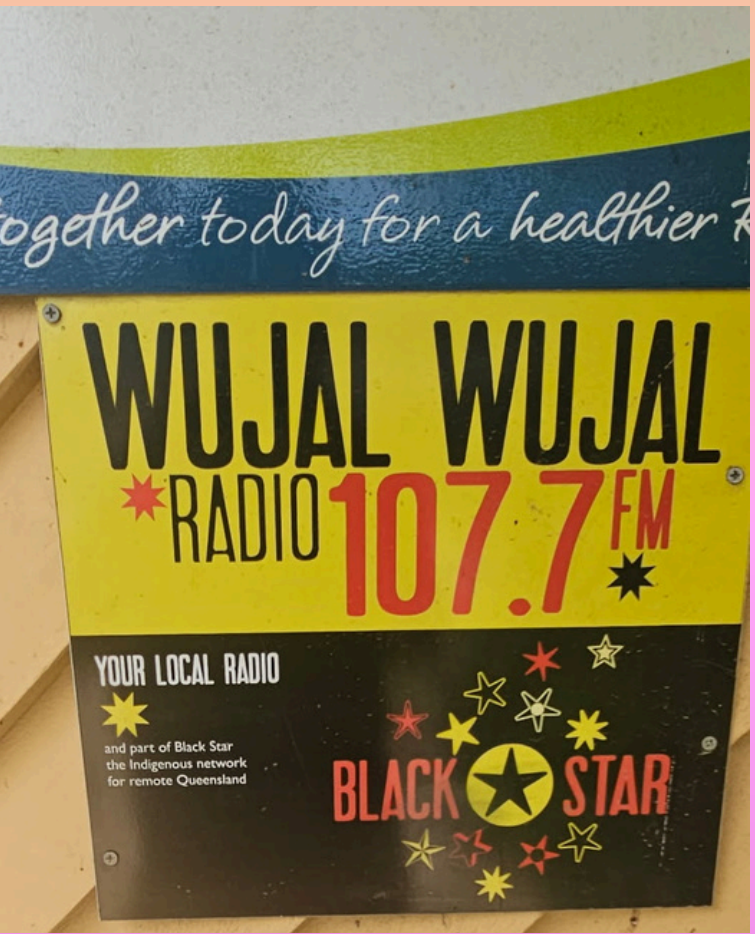

	<p>Know where you can ride</p> <p>Footpaths, shared paths, bike paths, and local streets and on-road bike lanes where the road limit is 50km/h or less.</p>		<p>Leave your phone alone when riding</p>
	<p>Always wear a helmet</p>		<p>No doubling</p> <p>Passengers are not allowed.</p>
	<p>Age 12+</p> <p>PMD riders must be 12 years old or more</p> <p>12-15 year olds must be supervised.</p>		<p>Don't drink and ride</p>
